Re: Wild Flower Walk with Simon Harrap - Tuesday, 18 June 2024 at 10.30am

Time to tell you about our next Wild Flower Walk with Simon Harrap at the Snettisham Coastal Path. This walk will offer a nice variety of coastal plants, including Yellow-horned Poppy, Sea Holly and Sea Spurge, while the scrub and grassy areas inland of the beach have stately Hoary Mullein, jewel-like Grass Vetchling and the apple pie-scented Sweetbriar. The going is mostly fairly easy and dry, but a bit 'up and down' in places so please wear suitable footwear.

Snettisham beach car park is at the end of Snettisham beach road, which is signed from the A149. The car park is beyond the turnings to the RSPB car park and the Snettisham caravan park, on the north side of the road, at TF 6477 3348 (postcode PE31 7PS). There is a charge for parking, so if possible you may wish to car share. If you are an RSPB member you can park at the RSPB car park, but this is a one km walk away. Numbers will be limited to around 14 and the cost will be £12 per person and restricted, at least initially, to members only. In order to reserve a place, please use the reply slip below.
